

Chartwells Culinary Scholarship Student Information

Description

The Chartwells Culinary Scholarship is designed to decrease financial burden for North Clackamas School District graduating seniors who are participants of the Sabin-Schellenberg Culinary program and will be seeking a certification in a Culinary Arts, Nutrition Services, Food Science, or similar.

Purpose

This scholarship was created to help students passionate about the culinary arts. This scholarship recognizes financial need can be a barrier to students wishing to pursue a certification in the area of Culinary Arts.

Amount of the Award (s)

The Chartwells Culinary Scholarship will award a scholarship of \$5,000 to two graduating seniors of North Clackamas Schools to go toward the cost of tuition and fees at the Culinary Program the students will attend. The total \$5,000 scholarship funds are to be distributed to the program upon request after the student is registered.

The amount of the award will be reviewed periodically by the Awards Committee of the North Clackamas Education Foundation (NCEF) in consultation with the donor and may be adjusted annually to account for funds available or changes in tuition costs.

Type of Award

The scholarship is non-renewable, and will be delivered directly to the certification/degree program once the student has provided proof of enrollment and requested the funds be applied to their student account.

Selection Criteria

The selection criteria for the scholarship are:

- 1. Applicants must have a cumulative high school GPA of at least 2.5.
- 2. Selected scholars will have demonstrated interest, passion, and promise in the field of Culinary Arts.
- 3. Preference will be given to:
 - First generation students: those who do not have a parent who has attained a degree beyond high-school.
 - Students who have faced other barriers or challenges
- 4. Students must attend a Culinary Program

Application Process (for high school seniors)

Applicants must submit:

- 1) A Counselor Recommendation Form
- 2) A completed Chartwells Culinary Scholarship Application
- 3) Two letters of reference, preferably from a NCSD Culinary Arts instructor, counselor, or--if you have been employed in a job or volunteer service related to the culinary arts—your supervisor.

Review Committee

The review committee will include, but is not limited to, a NCEF board member; the chair or vice-chair of the NCEF Awards Committee; and the donor or a designated representative of the donor.

Announcements

The scholarship will be announced and presented by the donor or a designated representative of the donor at the scholarship and awards ceremony of the High-School of the student who is receiving the award. If the donor or the donor's representative is unable to attend, the scholarship will be presented by the NCEF Executive Director or board member. Scholars will also be announced on the Foundation website and social media.
