This scholarship was created to help students passionate about the culinary arts. This scholarship recognizes financial need can be a barrier to students wishing to pursue a certification in the area of Culinary Arts.

Please submit the following as three separate documents;

- 1. NCEF Bridges to Success Scholarship Application located at nc-foundation.org/applications all scholarship applicants must submit this application, all applicants will be entered into the opportunity to receive a Bridges to Success Scholarship, if applicants are applying for more than one scholarship, they need only submit this application once.
- 2. A Counselor Recommendation Form located at nc-foundation.org/applications— all scholarship applicants must submit this form, only one form needed per applicant if submitting multiple scholarship applications. Applications will not be considered without this form.
- 3. A document containing the following;
 - 1. Essay 1: describe your passion for and interests in culinary arts, your career aspirations; and your qualities and attributes as a professional and leader (no more than 1000 words)
 - 2. Essay 2: describe a financial, family, or personal obstacle that you have had to overcome (no more than 500 words); and Part 3: describe how Culinary Arts have impacted your life in a positive way (no more than 500 words).
 - 3. Two letters of reference, preferably from a NCSD Culinary Arts instructor, counselor, or--if you have been employed in a job or volunteer service related to the culinary arts—your supervisor.

All scholarship applications must be submitted by midnight Friday April 30th, 2021
