- 2. A Counselor Recommendation Form located at **nc-foundation.org/applications** all scholarship applicants must submit this form, only one form needed per applicant if submitting multiple scholarship applications, **applications will not be considered without this form.**
- 3. A document answering the following questions;
 - a. What institutions are you likely to attend? for each, list the school and its location.
 - b. What musical instrument do you play?
 - c. How long and in what ways, have you been engaged in instrumental music? (Short Answer (no more than 300 words))
 - d. What is your intended area of music study, and why are you inspired to pursue this area? (Short Answer (no more than 300 words))
 - e. Please write an essay including;
 - 3.e.i. Part 1: describe your passion for and interests in instrumental music, your career aspirations; and your qualities and attributes as a professional and leader (no more than 1000 words); and
 - 3.e.ii. Part 2: describe a financial, family, or personal obstacle that you have had to overcome (no more than 500 words).
